The Treasure the Truth Capital Fund Campaign (TTC) represents Crean Lutheran South High School's long range, sustainable advancement campaign, which was created to financially ensure the school's mission of "Proclaiming Jesus Christ Through Excellence in Education."

In tandem with tuition dollars, the TTC plays a vital role in promulgating first-rate Christian education through the development of valuable infrastructure that will efficiently and effectively develop the next generation of Christian leaders.

Incrementally developed throughout the 2008-09 school year, the Treasure the Truth Campaign officially launched as a capital campaign on July 1, 2009, as part of a \$90 million dollar project designed to bring a state-of-the-art, "green" campus to the heart of Orange County.

With the school poised to break ground on the initial \$44 million first phase of the campus during the first semester of the 2009-10 academic year, the TTC is focused on raising \$46 million over the next eight years in order to complete Phase 2 and 3 by 2017.

To make our goal, Crean Lutheran asks you to prayerfully consider making a commitment to this important project by personally supporting the campaign in any number of ways that are available. The TTC is equipped to facilitate donations in several ways. If you have any questions, or if you wish to donate but have specific needs, please contact the CLS Advancement Office.

Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT): The easiest way to support CLS is by visiting the "Giving" link on the CLS website, www.cls.shs.org, and clicking on the Donate link.

Cash Donations: Annual gifts paid by check should include a note in the memo section "TTC" and be accompanied by the TTC Pledge Card.

Matching Gifts: All donors are strongly encouraged to check with their employers about matching gift opportunities. Visit the Giving link for more details.

Billing: Individuals who do not wish to use the EFT option may spread donations out over the course of the year by indicating preferred billing terms on the pledge card.

Credit Card: CLS can facilitate donations through by processing VISA and MasterCard Transactions. Please note that vendor fees reduce net donations to CLS by 3 percent.

Stock & Property: The TTC welcomes gifts of appreciated stock and other securities which may make the donor eligible for tax savings.

Life Insurance & Planned Giving: There are many ways in which life insurance policies may be used to make a contribution. A number of other planned gift vehicles, such as bequests, remainder trusts, and other annuities are also available to make a more generous gift to CLS while receiving financial benefits.

Gifts-in-Kind: Crean Lutheran welcomes donated services that would ordinarily be purchased for operational purposes, for the furtherance of advancement efforts (e.g. auction items), and/or for the development of the permanent campus.

Passive Sales & Rewards Programs: CLS community members can support the school on a daily basis by patronizing businesses that direct a percentage of sale to CLS. Visit the Passive Sales link under "Giving" at www.cls.shs.org.

Note: Restricted vs. Unrestricted Gifts: Gifts that are earmarked for specific programs (e.g. restricted gifts) are eligible for tax deductible credit, less the cost of any tangible goods-services received, but are not eligible for to receive the benefits listed on the benefit chart. Donations to the TTC (e.g. unrestricted gifts) are eligible to receive the benefits listed on the benefits chart.
